## CARTOGRAPHIC CAMPSITES OF 1869: MAJOR POWELL'S MOMENTOUS POSSIBILITIES by Richard D. Quartaroli 2009 GTS

"The Major as usual has chosen the worst camping-ground possible," George Y. Bradley secretly wrote on June 11, 1869, in the Canyon of Lodore. Bradley, a crewmember of John Wesley Powell's expedition down the Green and Colorado rivers, continued, "If I had a dog that would lie where my bed is made tonight I would kill him and burn his collar and swear I never owned him."

Many Powell 1869 campsites of his momentous pioneer river trip remain unknown to this day, but have had speculative campsite identification. Powell and his men spent 25% of their 99-day river trip in the Grand Canyon. I would like to commemorate the 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Powell's successful river trip in this brief poster presentation, relying on the following sources, and my own best guesses.
